"The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ, and he shall reign forever and ever!" And the twenty-four elders who sat before God on their thrones fell on their faces and worshipped God, saying: "We give You thanks, O Lord God Almighty, The One who is and who was and who is to come, because You have taken Your great power and reigned. The nations were angry, and Your wrath has come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that You should reward Your servants the prophets and the saints, and those who fear Your name, small and great, and should destroy those who destroy the earth."

This week we're wrapping up the Judgments of the Tribulation. As we look at the Trumpet and Bowl judgments, we realize that the trials and "tribulations" that we experience now are nothing compared to what is coming. Nonetheless, we do experience challenges at times in our lives. Maybe you or someone close to you is going through a hard time right now. It could be related to the economy, it could be the death of someone close, or it could be strife within marriage or family. This week take some time to share your struggles with your brothers and have them pray for you.

Read the Proverb and the section of Psalm 119 that corresponds with the calendar day *example:*
If it's the 1st day of the month, read Proverbs 1 and Psalm 119:1-8 (Aleph)

This week we consider the Judgments and Times of the Seven Trumpets and Seven Bowls:

Mon: Trumpets 1 through 6: "The first angel sounded..." Revelation 8-9

Tue: The Little Book, the Witnesses and the 7th Trumpet: Revelation 10-11

Wed: The Dragon, the Beasts, The Woman: Revelation 12-14

Thu: The Bowls: "Go and pour out the bowls of the wrath of God..." Revelation 15-16

Fri: Babylon Falls, Christ Returns: "King of Kings and Lord of Lords" Revelation 17-19
